
Beginning May 1: 2021-2026 Regional Medical Library Cooperative Agreements

NLM awards new five-year cooperative agreements to seven institutions to serve as Regional Medical Libraries and four institution selected as National Coordinating Offices.

AIM 4:

Region 6 will collaborate with other RMLs, Offices and Centers, and the NNLM Evaluation Center to achieve continuity of service during large-scale threats, disasters, and localized emergencies to limit interruption in access to health information.



A I M 7:

Region 6 staff will partner with organizations and members across the 7-state region to identify technology barriers and support evidence-based programming that addresses audiences impacted by the digital divide.



AIM 8:

In collaboration with the National Evaluation Center, Region 6 staff will conduct formative and summative evaluations of the effectiveness, impact, and value of the RML program to inform and improve outreach, engagement, and education programs.


